Special Instructions:

1. Please fill out the reverse side of this form and place on dashboard of vehicle upon arrival to campus.
2. There are officers throughout campus assisting with the move-in process. Please listen closely for further instructions.
3. In most cases parking is limited by the residence halls. After unloading, you will be required to move your vehicle to the Markle Parking Deck, Sullivan Deck, Easton Quad – grass area or 901 Bushkill Drive.
4. Upon arrival to a student's residence hall, there will be Resident Advisor's (RA's) issuing keys, FOB's and further instructions.
5. There will be fraternity/sorority students and Athletic team players assisting in moving in belongings. This allows for a quick move-in process.
6. If separated, make arrangements with family members on where you plan on meeting each other.

NOTE: South College Drive is a One-Way street and very narrow. Three residence halls (South College, Ruef Hall and Keefe Hall) reside on this roadway. This roadway will back up. Please follow all officer's instructions on where to park to unload. You will be required to move your vehicle immediately upon unloading. We will have you unloaded in an orderly and timely fashion.
