Offering single bedroom suites and double bedroom semi-suites, McCartney North and McCartney South are the newest housing options for upper-level Lafayette students.

McCARTNEY NORTH

Residential units offer:

- Single bedrooms with twin XL bed, desk, chair, and chest of drawers
- In-unit bathrooms
- Common area with full-size refrigerator, cabinets, sink, dining table, and chairs
- Central air conditioning

Unit types:

- 4 bedroom / 2 bath suites
- 3 bedroom / 1 bath suites
- Studios (*single occupancy*)

McCARTNEY SOUTH

Residential units offer:

- Double bedrooms with twin XL bed, desk, chair, and chest of drawers
- Between-unit shared bathrooms
- Central air conditioning

Unit types:

- 2 bedroom / 1 bath semi-suites (*two double bedrooms connected by a shared bathroom*)

AMENITIES

Both buildings include:

- Two community kitchens with oven and induction cooktop, microwave, refrigerator, and dishwasher
- Laundry room with coinless (free) operated machines
- Two study lounges
- Elevator

Retail space:

- College Bookstore in McCartney North
- Diner in McCartney South

HOW TO APPLY?

Applications will be available in MyHousing starting February 12th.
Deadline is March 1st.

HOW DOES THE ASSIGNMENT PROCESS WORK?

Assignment process will be seniority-based. All intended roommates must submit an individual application and complete the roommate matching process in MyHousing.

WHEN IS ASSIGNMENT NOTIFICATION?

Assignment confirmation will be sent to students by March 13th.

McCartney North and McCartney South are owned by a private developer that is partnering with Lafayette College in the operation of the facilities. These two residence halls will be governed by the policies in the Lafayette College Student Handbook and offer a community living experience consistent with other residence halls.

What do I need to know?

McCartney North & South CONTRACT DETAILS

McCartney students will sign a housing contract with the property owner. Some terms of the McCartney contract vary from the College housing contract, including:

- **TERM:** The housing contract is for both the fall and spring semesters (the full academic year). Contract cancellations are by request and not guaranteed.
- **STUDY ABROAD:** Spring semester study-abroad students are able to be released from the contract by arranging with an eligible student to take their space for the spring semester.
- **ROOM CHANGES:** Requests to be released from the contract to relocate into College-owned housing and Greek chapter houses are not guaranteed.
- **CO-SIGNER:** A financial guarantor (typically a parent) is required to complete the housing contract.
