# Residential units offer:

- Heat and air conditioning with in-unit thermostats

 2 bedroom / 1 bath semi-suites (two double bedrooms connected by a shared bathroom)

# **HOW TO APPLY?**

Tator North and McCartney South are available through the Senior Only and Occupancy Lottery Events.

McCartney North and McCartney South are owned by a private developer that has partnered with Lafayette College in the operation of the facilities. These two residence halls are governed by the policies in the Lafayette College Student Handbook and offer a community living experience consistent with other residence halls.



# What do I need to know?

McCartney students will sign a housing contract with the property owner. Some terms of the McCartney contract vary from the College housing contract, including:

- TERM: The housing contract is for both the fall and spring semesters (the full academic year). Contract cancellations are by request and not guaranteed.
- STUDY ABROAD: Spring semester study-abroad students are able to be released from the contract by arranging with an eligible student to take their space for the spring semester.
- CO-SIGNER: A financial guarantor (typically a parent) is required to complete the housing contract.
- PAYMENT OPTIONS: Students can use financial aid to pay for their housing, and a payment plan is available for those who prefer monthly installments.

# YOUR LIVING EXPERIENCE

#### **RAs**

RAs reside in each residential community to foster relationships, plan programs, and provide support for residents.

#### **HOUSING FEE**

The housing fee is \$13,268 per year/ \$6,634 per semester and is paid separately.

#### **MEAL PLAN**

Students are required to have a meal plan and may choose a 14 or 20 meal plan.

#### **CAMPUS SUPPORT**

Students have the same support from campus including Public Safety.

#### **CHECKPOINTS**

Electronic access is consistent with other residence halls including cross visitation.

### **FRIENDS**

Students can select with friends in groups of three or four for Tator North and pairs of two or four for McCartney South.

#### **BREAK HOUSING**

Tator North and McCartney South follow the same opening and closing schedule as other residence halls.

# NETWORK CONNECTIVITY

Students have the same wireless access to the Lafayette network as other residence halls.

#### **CABLE**

Cable service may be contracted through the College provider, Service Electric.
